Directed by John Landis

TO-GA! TO-GA! TO-GA! Perhaps the most quotable college comedy ever made, John Landis and the National Lampoon team crafted an indelible & debaucherous demolition of higher education with *Animal House*. At Faber College in 1962, uptight Dean Wormer puts the Delta Tau Chi House on double secret probation in his plans to shut down the fraternity for good. Featuring a pitch-perfect cast, including John Belushi in a standout role as iconic party animal Bluto Blutarsky.

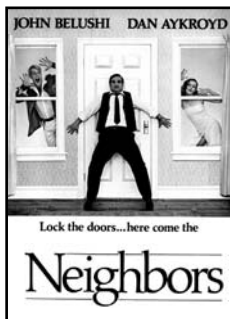


Saturday • April 13

The Blues Brothers (1980) [133 min.]

Directed by John Landis

John Belushi and Dan Aykroyd bring their iconic *Saturday Night Live* characters to the big screen in John Landis' *The Blues Brothers*, a turbo-charged and music-infused, eminently quotable and chaotically outrageous comedic adventure following the boys on a mission from God to raise money and save an orphanage. Featuring James Brown, Cab Calloway, Ray Charles, Carrie Fisher, Aretha Franklin, Henry Gibson, John Lee Hooker, John Candy and the Blues Brothers Band.

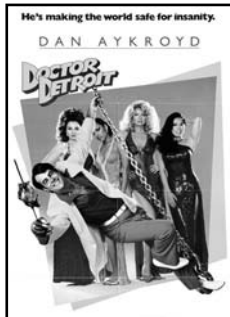


Saturday • April 20

Neighbors (1981) [94 min.]

Directed by John G. Avildsen

In a not-too-distant suburb, a nice, ordinary family man (John Belushi) is about to have his quiet life turned into a comic nightmare. He's about to meet the *Neighbors*. And the enthusiastic interlopers next door (Dan Aykroyd & Cathy Moriarty) will have him questioning his sanity as their relationship quickly escalates into suburban warfare over the course of one turbulent night. Belushi & Aykroyd memorably play against type in the dark comedy that would prove to be Belushi's final film role.

Doctor Detroit (1983) [91 min.]

Directed by Michael Pressman

In the grand tradition of screen classics such as *Dr. No* and *Doctor Zhivago*, comes the hilariously madcap *Doctor Detroit!* When a fast-talking pimp makes him his patsy in a tough turf war, a mild-mannered college professor (Dan Aykroyd) will have to learn to balance class work with late nights while becoming the fancy-dressing, flashy-dancing, death-defying, jacuzzi-dipping, dynamic defender of decency for four working girls (including Lynn Whitfield and Fran Drescher). Look for a guest appearance by James Brown.

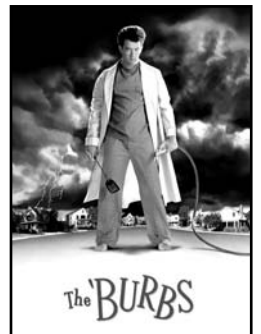

The 'Burbs (1989) [101 min.]

Directed by Joe Dante

Living in the suburbs can feel like a nightmare. And in Joe Dante's *The 'Burbs*, the nightmare is real. On leave from work, stir-crazy patriarch Ray (Tom Hanks) begins to suspect, with some not-too-subtle encouragement by his gossiping neighbors (Rick Ducommun, Bruce Dern), that the creepy new family that just moved in to their picturesque cul-de-sac might be a bunch of murderers! This classic cult comedy is possibly the greatest film ever made about the paranoiac life of the suburbs and teaches everyone how (not) to be a good neighbor.

Jurassic Park (1993) [127 min.]

Directed by Steven Spielberg

Director Steven Spielberg delivers one of cinema's all-time greatest blockbusters, crafting Michael Crichton's book into dino-mite big screen entertainment. When a select team of scientists get a sneak peek at an island park populated with cloned dinosaurs, the tables are turned as the toothy exhibits get free and go on the hunt for tasty humans. Featuring groundbreaking special effects that still invoke awe, an iconic cast, and a timeless John Williams score, *Jurassic Park* remains a crackerjack sci-fi thriller for the ages.

Hop (2011) [95 min.]

Directed by Tim Hill

From the creators of hit franchises such as *Despicable Me* & *The Secret Life of Pets*, comes the live-action meets state-of-the-art-animation holiday favorite *Hop*. With his father's expectations weighing down on his furry little shoulders, the Easter Bunny's teenage son (E.B., voiced by Russell Brand) runs off to Hollywood to chase his dream of making it big as a drummer. There he teams up with an out-of-work slacker, Fred (James Marsden), and together they go on a hilarious series of misadventures, culminating in a Battle For Easter, which teaches them both the importance of family and what it takes to finally grow up.

The electrifying duo of Phil Lord and Chris Miller served up a delectable animated delight in their critically-acclaimed directorial debut, a blockbuster adaptation of the beloved children's book. When an aspiring inventor builds a machine that causes food to fall from the sky, he'll soon discover he may have bitten off more than he can chew.
